Guide to taking part in the webinar

If you have never attended Adobe Connect before, please, do the following test:

https://connect.funet.fi/common/help/en/support/meeting_test.htm

- When you are logging into Adobe Connect, log in as a guest. Enter your organization, first name, last name, and clickLogin.
- If you are a student or a staff member from any Finnish University or Polytechnic, you should be able to log in using your Haka-credentials. Please, use them if you have them.
- When you enter Adobe Connect meeting room, you should be able to hear what one or more of the hosts is speaking if they have enabled their microphones.

If you cannot hear any sound from your speakers/headphone, please do following:

1. Make sure that the loudspeaker icon is green in the toolbar next to the Meeting menu.
 2. If it is not green, press it and it should turn green.
 3. If you still cannot hear any sound, select the drop-down menu from the speaker icon. Select Adjust Speaker Volume.
- If you still cannot hear any sound from your speakers/headphone, try the machine sounds by playing a video from youtube.com etc. If that doesn't work, your computer sounds are turned off or very low. Work that out before using Adobe Connect.
 - If your computer sounds work but Adobe Connect sounds do not, select Meeting --> Exit Adobe Connect. Then re-enter the meeting address https://connect.funet.fi/dediwe_webinar/
